When I fail, C: _____

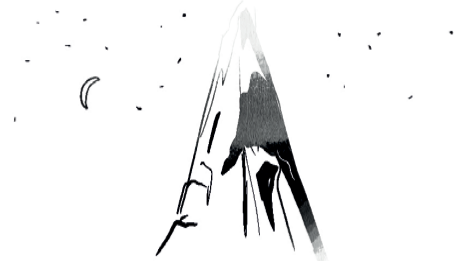
may be the first feeling I feel.

It's okay if today at **B**: _____

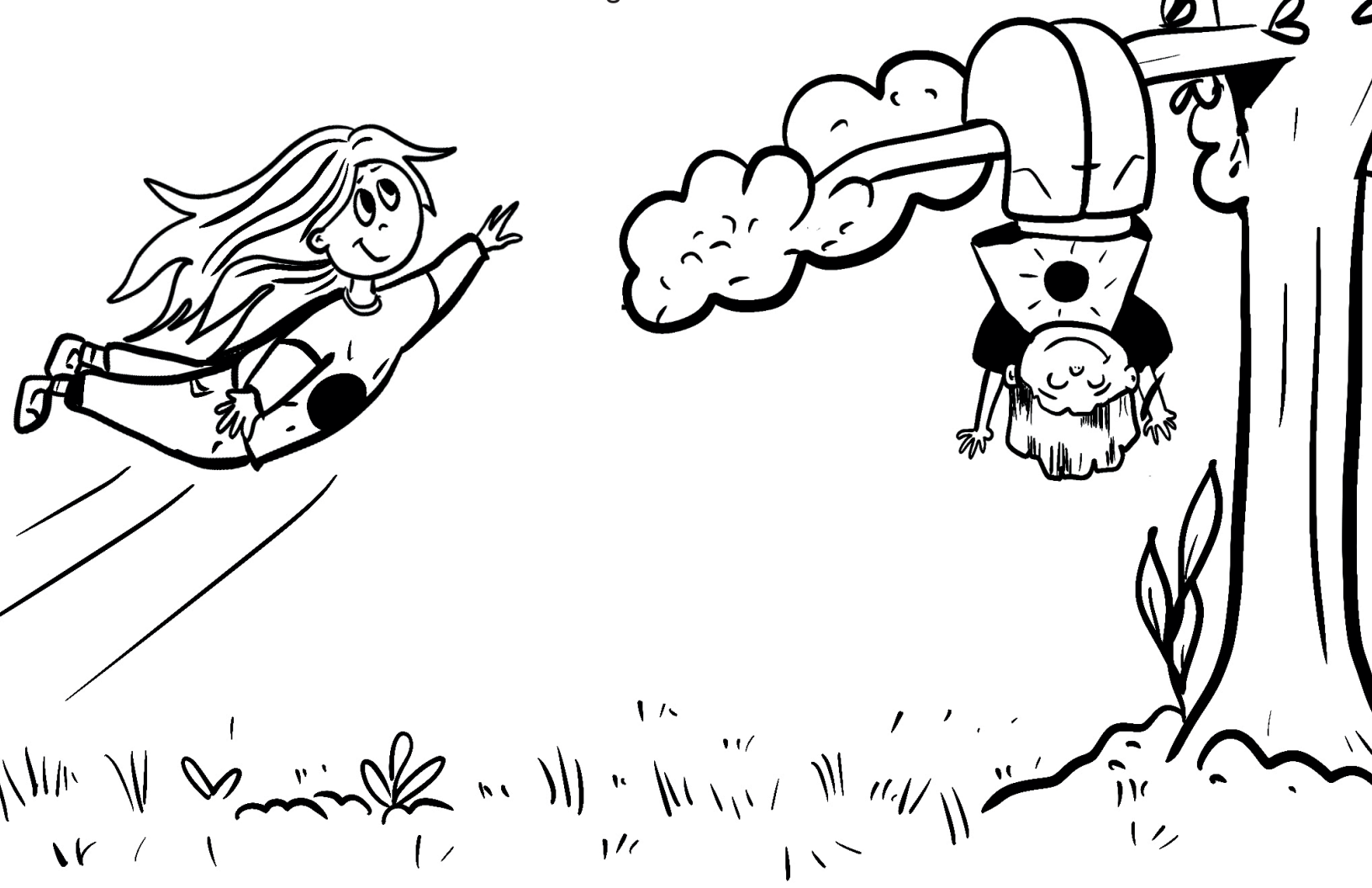
I don't succeed,
